- Review all funding requests submitted by the organizations of the Special Interest Council
- Attend weekly (or as needed) Special Interest Funding Board meetings
- Attend Student Senate sponsored Funding Board training held each semester
- Serve as a resource for Special Interest organizations in the preparation of request
- Remain unbiased in reviewing of requests
- Encourage co-sponsorship of programs

### Requirements:

- Applicants must have a cumulative grade point average of a 2.5 and maintain that average each semester.
- Applicants must be enrolled in six credits or more for Winter and Fall semesters.
- Applicants may not be graduating prior to Winter 2010.
