SELECTION PROCESS FOR WINTER 2010 SEMESTER

There will be seven voting members of the Service and Advocacy Funding Board chaired by a Student Senate Financial Liaison. The appointment will begin January 2010 and run through April 2010. Application must be submitted by **November 16, 2009** to the Community Service Learning Center, Attn: Valerie Jones (or via email to jonesval@gvsu.edu). Please sign up for an interview when submitting your applications. Interviews will be held on 11/17 from 4-9pm and 11/18 from 9am- 2pm.

Duties:

- Review all allocations submitted by the organizations of the Service and Advocacy Council
- Attend weekly (or as needed) Service and Advocacy Funding Board meeting
- Attend Student Senate sponsored allocations training held each semester
- Serve as a resource for Service and Advocacy organizations in the preparation of request
- Remain unbiased in reviewing of applications
- Encourage co-sponsorship of programs
- Maintain regular communication with council advisor and senate liaison
- Attend Service and Advocacy Council meetings as necessary

Requirements:

- Applicants must have a cumulative grade point average of a 2.5 and maintain that average each semester
- Applicants must be enrolled in six credits or more for Winter 2010 semester
- Applicants may not be graduating prior to April 2010
- Applicants must hold membership in a Service and Advocacy organization that is in good standing
- **During the Winter 2010 semester, applicants must be available on Mondays from 6:30-8:30pm for Funding Board Meetings. Applicants unavailable for this time will not be considered.**

Notes:

- No more than one executive board member from the same organization will be selected to serve on the Funding Board.
