Nomination Requirements for Regents

Candidate Eligibility:

- Each candidate must be a junior or senior (55+ credits).
- Each candidate must have good standing with the University.
- Each candidate must be enrolled for a minimum of 12 credit hours.
- Each candidate must have a GPA higher than the all undergraduate average of **3.060**.
- Candidacy is limited to undergraduate students of Grand Valley State University only.

Candidate Nominations:

- Candidates must be members of a Recognized Student Organization, Registered Team, Residence Hall, Living Center, or Apartment Complex.
- Each organization, team, hall, living center, or apartment complex may nominate one female candidate and one male candidate (single sex organizations are allowed to only nominate one candidate based on the gender of the organization).
- Candidates may be nominated by only ONE organization.
- A candidate can not be nominated if they have been on court in previous years.
- The candidate must turn in the Regents Candidates Nomination Form of the **Office of Student Life by 5 p.m. on Friday, October 2, 2009**.
- A letter of endorsement from the candidate's organization must accompany the nomination form.
- The candidate must fill out the Nomination Form completely answering the questions along with an attached resume.
- Interviews for court will be held on **Thursday October 8th – Friday October 9th**. The candidate must sign up for a 15 minute interview slot in order to be considered for court. Candidates may sign up for a time, only upon submitting their completed application.

Candidate Appearances:

- The Homecoming Court will be announced on Monday, October 12, 2009 at the Homecoming Regent Serenade.
- The Regents and the Court will be announced during the football game, and four tickets will be provided for football game for each Homecoming Court member.
- Dress code for the Homecoming Court should be business casual.

Elections:

- Voting will start Tuesday, October 13th at 12:01 a.m. and end October 15th at Midnight.
- All voting will be done online.
- Each student may vote for ONE female and ONE male candidate and may only vote once.
- The female and male Regents who receive the highest number of votes will be crowned. The Court will consist of five female and male candidates, who will be chosen by the Regent Committee consisting of GVSU faculty and staff.
