3. ELECTIVES

An additional **two** courses totaling **six hours**. Students can select these courses from among those listed above, taking a second course in a category (but note that students can apply either, but not both, PSY 301 and PSY 364), or students can select from any Psychology course that is not in one of the categories listed above or otherwise required for the major (PSY 304, PSY, 305, PSY 306, PSY 307, PSY 324, PSY 311, PSY 315, PSY 316, PSY 317, PSY 325, PSY 326, PSY 349, PSY 357, PSY 362, PSY 367, PSY 368, PSY 370, PSY 375, PSY 377, PSY 380, PSY 381, PSY 399, PSY 410, PSY 413, PSY 445, PSY 490, and PSY 499). Students also have the option of applying for no more than **one** of the following: SS 260, SS 261, SS 381, SS 382.

COGNATE

Psychology Majors complete the B.S. cognate as part of the major, by taking PSY 300 and PSY 400, as well as their prerequisite, STA 215. Students who have completed 3rd semester in a foreign language have the *option* of selecting the B.A. cognate. It matters little to employers or graduate schools whether the degree is a B.S. or a B.A.
