Grand Valley State University Libraries will provide the public with free and unrestricted access to online government information provided through the Federal Depository Library Program in accordance with section 1911 of Title 44, *United States Code*. The public is able to access these materials on the Government Documents PCs in the Zumberge and Steelcase libraries. Patrons are not required to provide any form of identification to use these computers, although they will need to see a librarian or staff person at the reference desk to login. Patrons using these computers are expected to adhere to the university's policies regarding the use of electronic resources.
