

New Curriculum Implementation

Transfer Student Plan

This plan is for the transfer student entering Fall 2011 and beyond, with our previous curriculum foundation requirements completed at another institution. In short, these students will find that all these classes will fit into the new major tracks. To enable the students to have more upper-level classes at GVSU, we will waive the foundation class ENG 215 and instead require an additional elective. Thus, the credit amount for the major (39 credits) remains the same for students beginning the major at GVSU or transferring in. Students coming in with 4-5 of the former foundation courses completed may waive ENG 215; students who have only 1-3 of these courses will be expected to take ENG 215 and complete the major as described in the Fall 2011 Catalog. The courses transferred in may, of course, be used toward the major in the new tracks.
