



The Association of Family Practice Physician Assistants is pleased to offer scholarship awards to previously graduated Physician Assistant Students who have **returned** to school to pursue a masters degree. The program may be on-site or a distance learning design. The amount is \$500 and will be awarded to two students. Awards are made to those who are members of the AFPPA, are employed in primary care, and are in good academic standing. Preference will be given to longstanding AFPPA members, those demonstrating professional leadership and community service.

**To apply for this scholarship:**

Please submit an essay (750 words or less) that describes your commitment to primary care medicine and how your current and past community involvement demonstrates this commitment. Describe your efforts to support and promote the PA profession. Also include why you are pursuing a masters degree.

Complete the registration form and forward it to a faculty member along with your statement. The faculty member then completes the faculty form and forwards the registration form, statement and faculty form from an official school email address.

Your application is scored based on your essay and faculty recommendation. Please give us a full understanding of why YOU deserve this award.

The application must be submitted in a Microsoft Word compatible format. PDF or scanned documents will not be considered.
