For purposes of research compliance and human subject oversight protections, Grand Valley State University is known to the federal government as an institutional organization, # IORG0002093.

The GVSU Institutional Review Board is known internally as the **Human Research Review Committee** (HRRC). Its federal IRB identification number is 00002615. Its Federalwide Assurance number is 00002829. Expiration November 16, 2010.

GVSU also serves as the IRB of record for Elkins Innovations Inc., Its FWA # 00007895. Expiration November 19, 2010

**Adoption of the Code of Federal Regulations.** It is the procedure of GVSU and the HRRC in conducting reviews and determining approvals of proposed research activities to comply with all provisions of the relevant sections of the Code of Federal Regulations unless the research is exempt under 45 CFR 46.101(b), to ensure the protection of the rights and welfare of human research subjects in all investigations conducted by GVSU faculty, staff, and students and GVSU-associated researchers.
