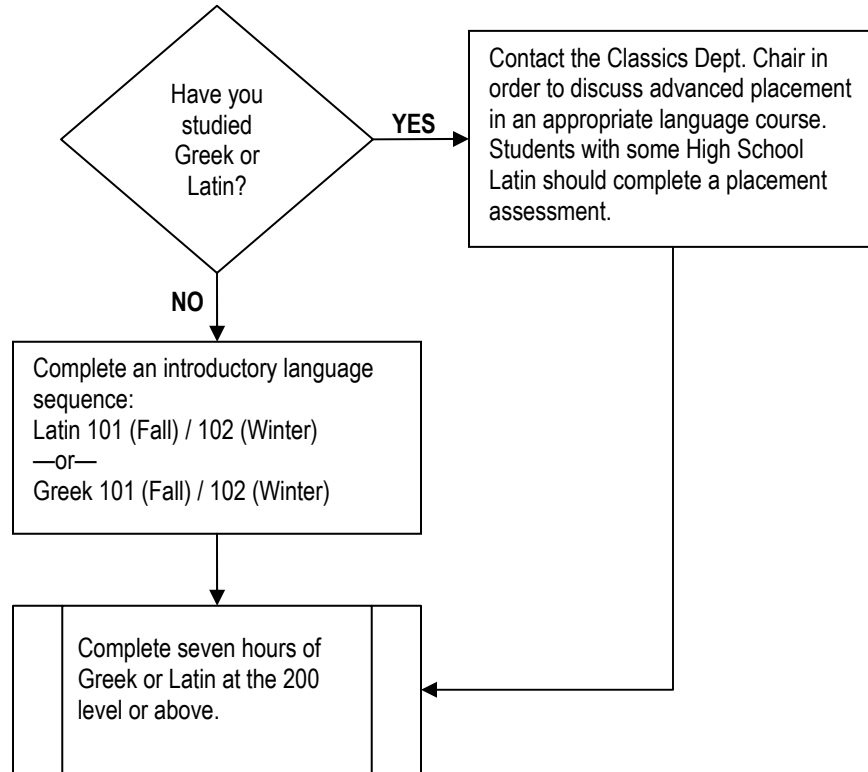


COMPLETING A CLASSICS MAJOR AT GVSU

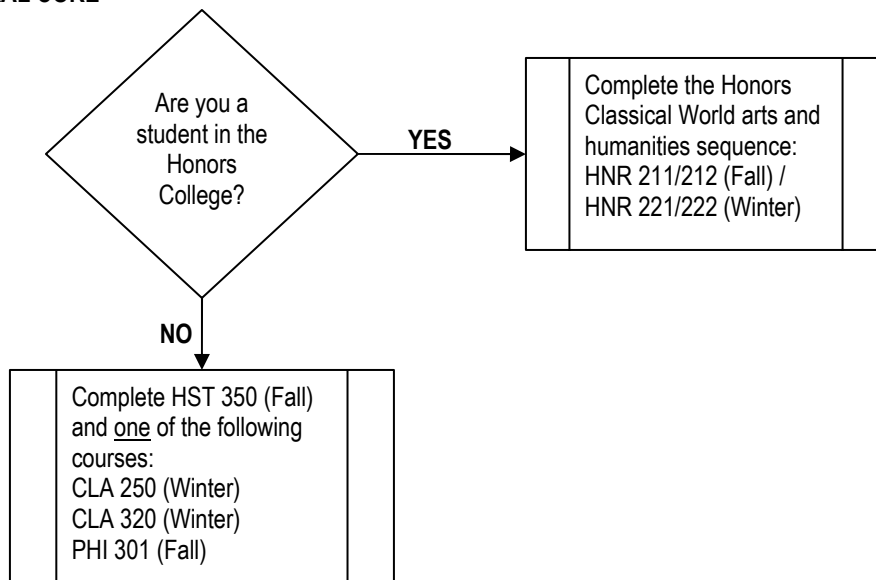
Completing a Classics Major at GVSU involves three steps (which may be completed simultaneously):

- (i) fulfilling the Language Core requirements;
- (ii) fulfilling the Cultural Core requirements; and
- (iii) fulfilling the requirements for one of the five available Emphases.

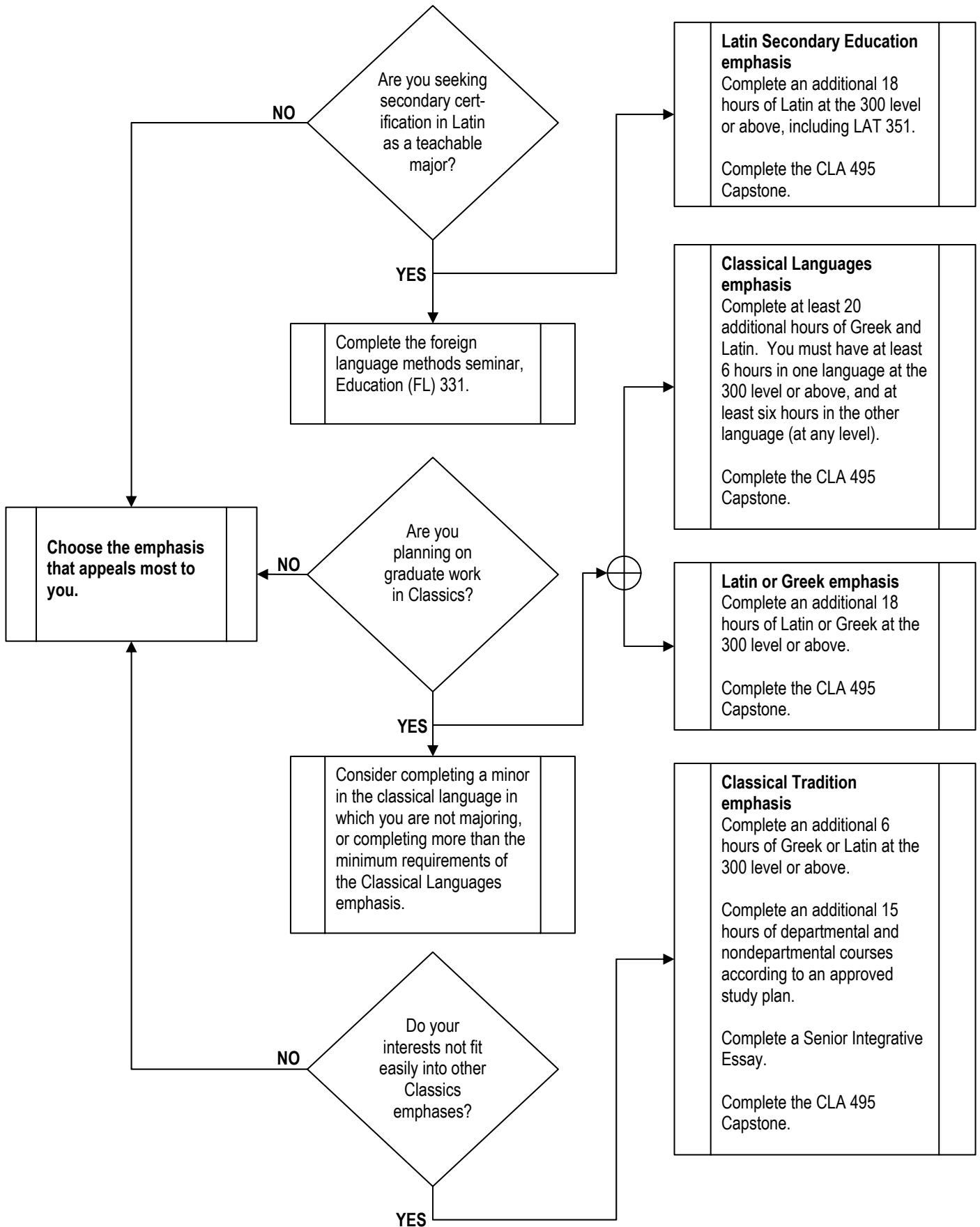
FULFILLING THE LANGUAGE CORE

FULFILLING THE EMPHASIS REQUIREMENTS



Choose the emphasis that appeals most to you.

Complete the foreign language methods seminar, Education (FL) 331.

Consider completing a minor in the classical language in which you are not majoring, or completing more than the minimum requirements of the Classical Languages emphasis.

Latin Secondary Education emphasis
Complete an additional 18 hours of Latin at the 300 level or above, including LAT 351.

Complete the CLA 495 Capstone.

Classical Languages emphasis
Complete at least 20 additional hours of Greek and Latin. You must have at least 6 hours in one language at the 300 level or above, and at least six hours in the other language (at any level).

Complete the CLA 495 Capstone.

Latin or Greek emphasis
Complete an additional 18 hours of Latin or Greek at the 300 level or above.

Complete the CLA 495 Capstone.

Classical Tradition emphasis
Complete an additional 6 hours of Greek or Latin at the 300 level or above.

Complete an additional 15 hours of departmental and nondepartmental courses according to an approved study plan.

Complete a Senior Integrative Essay.
