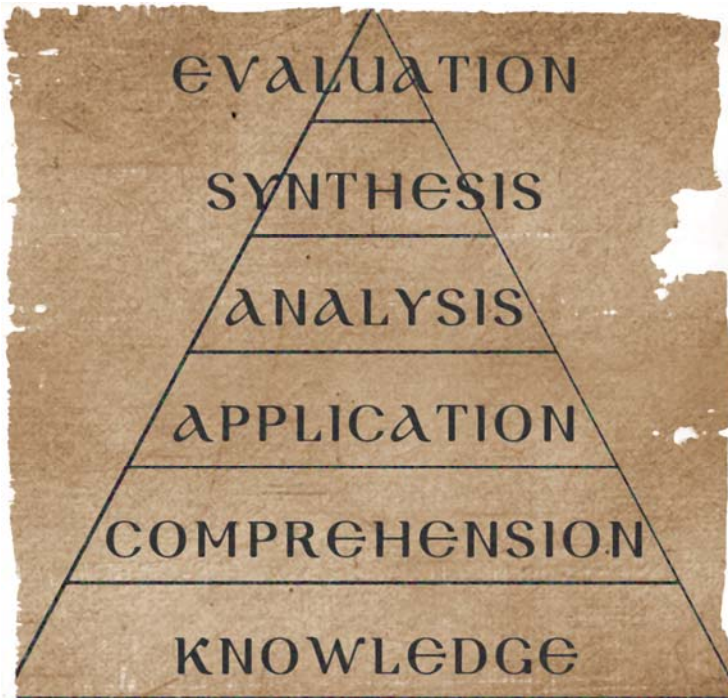
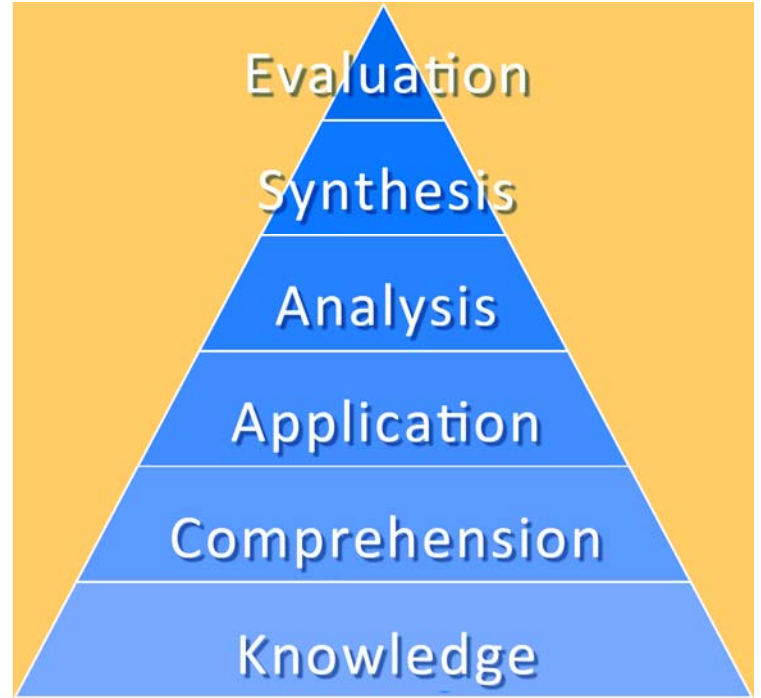


# 1<sup>ST</sup> CENTURY SKILLS.
