Winneba & Accra, Ghana This program offers students the distinctive service-learning experience to learn about a fascinating culture through the holistic combination of the classroom, service-learning placements, and a wide spectrum of experiences in Ghana, Africa.

During the first week, students stay at the University of Ghana in Accra for the first segment of a social science course to learn about nongovernmental organizations (NGOs). Students then travel to the coastal village of Winneba to begin their five-week service-learning course component. For this service learning component, students can work with governmental and non-governmental organizations that focus on health, education, human trafficking, and issues concerning potable water.

Students pursuing a medical career have the option to volunteer with the Ghana Health Service System in Winneba, Ghana.

HNR 281: Ghanaian Life & Culture (3 credits to social science) AND

HNR 399: Independent Study: Service-Learning (3 credits to junior seminar) OR

HNR 499: Senior Project (3 credits)

Non-Honors students can receive both World Perspectives general education and independent study credits.
