 Application Deadline: **January 15<sup>th</sup>**

- GVSU Graduate Application with \$30 application (fee waived for previous GVSU students)
- Official transcripts from **ALL** colleges and universities attended (except GVSU)
- At least 9 credit hours of prerequisite coursework (excluding statistics & elective) must be completed at the time of application.
- Provide a written plan detailing degree and prerequisite completion by start of program
- Minimum grade of **"C"** required in all prerequisite coursework
- Minimum GPA of 3.0 required in prerequisites and last 60 hours
- Minimum 50 hours of volunteer experience under the supervision of a licensed Occupational Therapist required at time of application
  - Document experiences on the '*Documentation of Experience Form*' (*required with application*)
- Completion of the '*Achievement Summary Form*' detailing accomplishments
- Two recommendations submitted through the GVSU electronic graduate application
  - One from a registered Occupational Therapist
  - One from an academic professor who can comment on your academic performance  
*(Non-traditional students may use an employer instead of a professor)*
- Students must meet all Technical Standards as indicated on the OT website

**NOTE: At the time of application all prerequisite courses must have been taken within the past 5 years**
