Guidelines: Students are awarded points for achievement in the areas of Practice, Leadership, Education, Research and Professional Socialization.

Scoring is done by the OST Admissions Committee. These criteria below are provided as a guide.

| Categorical Criterion (Maximum point award per category is 5.00)* | Points |

| <p>Practice = any paid work involving direct patient contact, such as</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. CNA/Nursing Assistant, intern .25 pts 2. Activity/exercise leaders .50 pts 3. Rehab (OT/PT) technician or aide .75 pts 4. Health care professional of any kind (AS or higher) 1.00 pts (RN, LSW, Ex. Phys, RRT, TRS, COTA) | <p>Max. 5.0 pts</p> |
| <p>Leadership = any leadership role in any capacity, such as</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Leadership role in any youth/service organization, such as <ol style="list-style-type: none"> i. Boy/Girl Scout Leader ii. Camp Counselor (e.g., Indian Trails) iii. Church Group Leader iv. Activity leader for non-profit organization 2. Officer or Committee Chair in any formal extracurricular organization .50 pts 3. Supervisor in an employment capacity, reporting to another .75 pts 4. Manager of a store or a business 1.00 pts | <p>Max. 5.0 pts</p> |
| <p>Education = any teaching role in any kind of organization, such as</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Sunday School Teaching .25 pts 2. Classroom Instructional Aide .50 pts 3. Tutor (group or individual) .75 pts 4. <u>Certified</u> activity instructor for a service organization 1.00 pts (e.g., Water Safety Instructor) | <p>Max. 5.0 pts</p> |
| <p>Research = any kind of research activity, such as</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Research papers/study participant/subject .25 pts 2. Research Assistant/input or collect data .50 pts 3. Involvement in analyzing research data for another .75 pts 4. Carried out independent research 1.00 pts | <p>Max. 5.0 pts</p> |
| <p>Professional Socialization = any volunteer work for those with health issues, the disabled, or members of underserved populations <u>not</u> with an occupational therapist</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Participation in volunteer <u>one-time</u> activity .25 pts 2. Participation in <u>ongoing</u> volunteer activity .50 pts 3. <u>Member</u> of planning committee for a major volunteer effort .75 pts 4. <u>Chair</u> of planning committee for a major volunteer effort 1.00 pts | <p>Max. 5.0 pts</p> |

| Temporal Criterion (<i>Added to categorical criterion</i>)** Time criteria are cumulative, that is, if an activity extends over one year, that extended time is added incrementally at value shown | Points |
|---|---------------|
| Completed in a single encounter, such as <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Shadow a therapist for an afternoon 2. One-time activity for a community or church group, like a Walk-a-Thon, or attendance at a charity event | .25 pts |
| Activity that extends three months or less <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Required ongoing participation for 1 - 3 months <ol style="list-style-type: none"> i. Summer activity ii. Community / church project 2. Is completed in 3 months or less | .25 pts |
| Ongoing activity that extends 4 - 5 months (one semester) | .25 pts |
| Ongoing activity that extends over 2 semesters (6 - 9 months) <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Tutorial work (any level) 2. Holding office in any organization for 1 academic year 3. Leading any project over 1 academic year | .50 pts |
| Ongoing activity that extends over a 10 - 12 month period <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Employment experiences 2. Organizational experiences (e.g., Scouting, social groups) | .75 pts |

****Examples:**

Sunday School Teaching (.25) over 3 years (3.0) = 3.25 points

Research Assistant for a professor (.50) over 2.0 years (2.0) = 2.50 points

Note: For employment not directly with consumers, credit will be given only for the length of time the candidate had involvement in any of these 4 Achievement Profile categories: Research, Education, Leadership, Professional Socialization
