Application Deadline: January 15th Students may apply to only one program, either the Traditional or Hybrid program.

- GVSU Graduate Application with \$30 application (fee waived for previous GVSU students)
- Official transcripts from <u>ALL</u> colleges and universities attended (except GVSU)
- At least 9 credit hours of prerequisite coursework (excluding statistics & elective) must be completed at the time of application.
- Prerequisite worksheet detailing course and degree completion
- Minimum grade of "C" required in all prerequisite coursework
- Minimum GPA of 3.0 required in prerequisites and last 60 hours
- Minimum 50 hours of volunteer experience under the supervision of a licensed Occupational Therapist required at time of application
 - Document experiences on the '<u>Documentation of Experience Form'</u> (required with application)
- Completion of the 'Achievement Profile Form' detailing accomplishments
- Two Recommendation Forms submitted through the GVSU electronic graduate application
 - One from a registered Occupational Therapist
 - One from an academic professor who can comment on your academic performance (Non-traditional students may use an employer instead of a professor)
