1. Spring/First Six-Week Courses Final Grade Reminders

Final grades for Spring 2023/1st six-week courses must be posted in Banner before noon, Monday, June 26.

Unit Heads – please notify AD Betty Schaner and Mona Silva of the designees for routing grading emails. In preparation for grading, please make sure you have accurate contact information for all faculty – tenured, tenure-track, affiliate, visitor and adjunct – in case outreach is needed for missing grades. This is especially important since so many spring classes are online and the faculty are not on campus.

Faculty – posting final grades in Blackboard does not complete the process. All grades must be posted in Banner. For instructions, visit <u>Banner Grade Entry Instructions</u>. You will also need to report the Last Date of Academic Activity (LDAA) for all students who are assigned a grade of W, F, or NC. Assigning Incomplete Grades - A grade of "I" (incomplete) is to be assigned only in truly extenuating circumstances and only if the student has completed most (minimum of 2/3) of the work required for the course. All faculty are required to submit an <u>online Incomplete Grade form</u> for each incomplete grade assigned.
