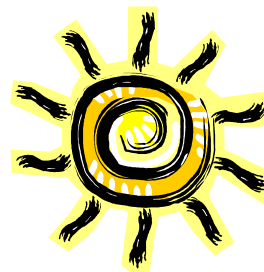

Master's in Physiology

- Georgetown University Medical Center offers a Master's Degree in Physiology** through their Complementary and Alternative Medicine (CAM) Program. This program is ideally suited for those **wishing to enter a health profession** and want to first learn about the **science of alternative therapies** and the skill to assess the **state-of-the-evidence** in these fields. This rigorous science-based curriculum is ideal for students who are considering a career in medicine or other health professions because **it may be completed in 11 months**. It is a one-of-a-kind program that teaches students how to critically evaluate the state-of-the-science for both conventional medicine and CAM. The program offers strong individual academic advising and support for the professional school applications, admission to PhD programs, and other career options. It also offers summer practicum placements at leading institutions in the US and at international sites to work on CAM-related projects. For additional information, go to <http://camprogram.georgetown.edu>. **Requirements: Minimum 3.0 GPA and solid MCAT, GRE or DAT scores. Class size is limited to 30 and admitted on a rolling basis, so don't delay! Deadline to apply is May 15.**
