•What majors should I declare in myBanner for the Special Education Program?

- 1. <u>Comprehensive Science and Arts for Teaching (CSAT)</u> for which you can choose either a Bachelor of Arts (B.A.) or Bachelor of Science (B.S.) degree
- 2. Special Education (second major only)

Note that no minor is required.

DECLARING THE APPROPRIATE MAJOR(S) FOR SPECIAL EDUCATION CERTIFICATION DECLARING THE MAJORS:

- 1. To declare your majors, enter myBanner from the GVSU homepage, log-in, select "Student", "Student Records", and then "Change Major." Click on the box labeled "Change Major 1/Program." On the next screen, click on the down-arrow in the box next to "New Major 1/Program." From the drop-down list, choose "Comprehensive Science & Arts for Teaching" selecting the BA (Bachelor of Arts) or BS (Bachelor of Science), hit "Submit", and then "Change to New Program." Return to the Change Major screen, and select "Add or Change Second Major" and choose "Special Education" from the drop down list, and then "Add Second Major."
- 2. No minor is required for CSAT majors
- 3. **Viewing the major requirements**: Once you declare your majors, you will need to enter the new myPath program from Banner to view your degree requirements. Choose "myPath" from the Student Records screen.

FOR THOSE STUDENTS WHO STARTED AT GVSU BEFORE FALL 2010:

- 4. Important note: Because the new majors take effect in Fall 2010 and not before, only students whose catalog year is 2010/2011 or later will have the ability to officially declare these majors. However, students who started at GVSU before the Fall semester of 2010 have the option of changing their catalog year to 2010/2011 or later so that they can declare the majors.
- 5. <u>If you started at GVSU BEFORE Fall 2010</u> and need to request a change in your catalog year, email <u>regdept@gvsu.edu.</u>

Include all the following information:

- a. Name
- b. G-number
- c. Phone number
- d. State your request to change your catalog year and specify which catalog year you wish: Fall 2010, or any present catalog year thereafter.
- e. State clearly that you are doing so in order to declare the CSAT and Special Education majors.

Once you get an email from the Registrar's Office confirming your change in catalog year, you will be able to declare both the CSAT and Special Education majors in myBanner as described above.
