

The research performed used NHANES data and IBMs SPSS statistical software to analyze a correlation between depression and nutrition/lifestyle variables: vitamin D, vitamin B12, saturated fatty acids, unsaturated fatty acids, fiber, and exercise. The study found that fiber and unsaturated fatty acid intake had a negative correlation with depression.

In this project we examined vegetation data from Utqiagvik, Alaska over the past 14 years for patterns relating to cover composition, growth height, and local weather using various graphs and mathematical models. We found the strongest positive linear relationship occurred between total August precipitation and average canopy height of graminoids.

Parkinson's disease (PD) progression is associated with increased levels of alpha-synuclein (aSyn). Employing PD-like cell culture, we sought to reduce aSyn accumulation using two microRNA mimics known to decrease aSyn expression. We found that these mimics increased expression rather than decreasing it.

#### **Research and Presentations**

I presented my work on PD at the Art and Science of Aging Conference, Student Scholars Day twice, at WMRUGS, and at the annual Society for Neuroscience conference. I later presented my work in amplicon sequencing in SARS-CoV-2 wastewater samples at WMRUGS and the Go With the Flow conference.
