Who do I talk to?

Pre-major (undecided) students have been assigned to an advisor in the Student Academic Success Center, 200 STU. Your Pre-major advisor is available to help you through the process of choosing a major and/or career which is precise fit for you by helping you identify interests, strengths, and weaknesses as they relate to majors and future careers. If referrals need to be made, your advisor will connect you to other campus resources. While you are going through the process of deciding on a major and/or related career, your advisor will guide you through your general education requirements and help you interpret university policies, procedures, and degree requirements.
