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## 6. New Business

a. Karen Gipson presented an overview of the clarification of "years towards tenure" language material that was distributed earlier, and projected further clarifying language. Tom Butcher addressed the senators and showed tenure progression charts. Discussion.

A <u>motion was made and seconded</u> to charge FPPC with revising the language at 2.7 to be consistent with the UAS recommendation of November 2012 (as summarized in the chart of the associated FPPC memo) and to examine relevant language at 2.5, 2.6 and 2.30.4 to ensure consistency. An additional recommendation is for FPPC to prepare a template of an example appointment letters for each scenario, showing the timeline for contract renewal, tenure, promotion and sabbatical eligibility. Discussion.

A <u>motion was made and seconded</u> to request that the Provost's Office send immediate clarification to deans and unit heads regarding 2.7, consistent with the UAS recommendation of November 2012 (as summarized in the chart of the associated FPPC memo), for hires currently in progress.

b. Jesse Bernal presented an overview of the Framework for Inclusion & Equity that was distributed earlier and requested endorsement from the Senate. Discussion. Questions were answered from the floor.

A <u>motion was made and seconded</u> to endorse this document and forward to UAS with a recommendation of support.

c. Karen Gipson presented an overview of possible ways to create a Diversity Affairs Committee, including membership, purpose, and potential duties for discussion. A recommendation was made to change the name to Inclusion and Equity Advisory Committee and to establish it as a standing committee of the senate. **MOTION:** The Executive Committee of the Senate charges FPPC with revising the language at 2.7 to be consistent with the UAS recommendation of November 2012 (as summarized in the chart of the associated FPPC memo) and to examine relevant language at 2.5, 2.6 and 2.30.4 to ensure consistency.
