ECS members asked the Chair to request a more encompassing response from FSBC on this part of its charge.</li> <li>c) The Chair reported that the Graduate Council has forwarded proposed revised faculty hand book language and these will be ready for review at the ECS meeting on October 9, 2009.</li> </ul>		
<ul> <li>a) Joe Godwin reported that the proposed budget from the state of Michigan eliminates the Michigan. Promise funding. He further reported that this equates to approximately 12 million dollars distributed to over 7,500 Grand Valley students.</li> <li>b) Joe Godwin reported that Provost Davis has spoken to the ECS Chair and Vice Chair, the Deans Council and Unit Heads regarding merging the 2<sup>nd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> year contract renewal into a single review to be held during faculty members' third year. Faculty members would be hired on a continuing contract and with suitable procedures developed to ensure that annual mentoring takes place.</li> </ul>

6. Old Business	<ul> <li>a. The Motion language for UAS consideration at the October 16, 2009 meeting regarding eligibility to vote in faculty personnel action that was distributed earlier was discussed.</li> <li>Robert Hendersen distributed additional material for consideration on the eligibility to vote motion options. Discussion.</li> <li>The Chair shared information on the increase in tenured faculty since 2004 as reported by the Human Resource Office to Provost Davis. There are currently 830 regular faculty; 314 of which have been hired since 2004 (an approximate increase of 37% in tenured/tenure-track lines).</li> <li>After extensive discussion, a Motion was made from the floor to present language to UAS limiting the eligibility to tenured faculty. Support.</li> <li>In discussion, ECS members noted the confusion that would be created by presenting Motion "options" before UAS. It was further noted that at its August 26, 2009 Retreat the ECS had already decided to modify the proposed revisions to the personnel language to permit tenured/tenure-track faculty members to be present and participate in the entire personnel process.</li> <li>A friendly amendment was accepted and the following motion was</li> </ul>
