- Cross-listing policies discussion  
Several points were raised or discussed. These included:
  - a. What is cross-listing? Is it clear in the catalog what a cross listed course is?

**Amendments:**

- b. How many cross listed courses currently exist in the university?
- c. Can cross-listed courses be counted in a major if it is cross listed? Discussion centered around the fact that if the courses are cross listed, that the content will be the same and therefore should be accepted by each department without need for review by departments. One course should count for another that it is cross listed for a major's requirement.
- d. Add to the course description-'cross listed with \_\_\_\_' and make this change throughout the catalog. This should not affect the description word limit. This will clarify the relationship between the two courses to students. Can this be done in Banner as well?
- e. Cross listing should not include x80 courses.
