Global Awareness Weeks

Each semester CECI sponsors a week for learning about a specific country or region. The featured country will be chosen by the CECI College Advisory and Communication Committee usually because there is a connection with a Fulbright Scholarship, study abroad program, or significant student or alumni population. Each week would include at least 4 events:

- The Keynote address, usually by a Fulbright Scholar or Study Abroad director. It may be organized as a panel.
- The screening of a movie or documentary that was filmed in the featured country or that portrays important events that occurred in that country.
- An overview of the connections between the featured country and West Michigan. This could include historical immigration, current ethnic communities and organizations, business ties, and students at GVSU. It may also be organized as a panel.
- A lunch featuring cuisine from the country.

Additional presentations or webinars might be connected to specific courses and deal with aspects of the featured country’s systems and practices related to education, social work, government, NGOs, tourism, or justice.

Fall 2023: The initial Global Awareness Week will be on Czechia. The keynote address will be by Salvatore Alaimo, Professor of Nonprofit Administration and Philanthropy, who spent 2022-23 on a Fulbright Scholarship at the Faculty of Social Studies at the University of Ostrava. Also presenting will be Barbara Nan Schichtel (MPA 05) of the Grand Rapids Historical Society who researching 60+ families who emigrated in chain fashion from the Sudeten Mountain villages around Chrastava, Czechia, to West Michigan.

Winter 2024: Global Awareness Week will be Ghana, featuring the study abroad program directed by Dianne Green-Smith

After the initial year establishes the template, CACC will solicit suggestions for future Global Awareness Weeks. Maybe trying to find one Asian and one Latin American country for balance.

We will try to get funding from Multicultural Affairs and PIC.
