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Each year the FSBC is asked to recommend to ECS/UAS a salary adjustment increment for the coming budget year. Given the time constraints of the fall semester, our recommendation needs to be forwarded to ECS, vetted, and voted upon by UAS before Thanksgiving. Over the past few years, FSBC has recommended CPI plus 1.5% as a minimum standard. This year is no different; FSBC requests a 2012-13 salary adjustment of at least Midwest CPI plus 1.5 percent.

The following table depicts the Average Salary Adjustment for the GVSU continuing faculty over the past five years. When the raises are adjusted for inflation (raise minus CPI), the result is the real percent change in salaries.
