SCIENTECH CLUB FOUNDATION INTERNSHIP SUMMER 2016

The Robert B. Annis Water Resources Institute is offering competitive spring/summer semester internships made possible, in part, by a gift from the Sciентech Club Foundation, located in Indianapolis, Indiana. One internship will be awarded to a Grand Valley **undergraduate** student majoring in the sciences, including engineering, computer, health, natural resource management, biological, chemical, mathematics, statistics, and physical sciences. The purpose of this internship is to broaden the student's perspective in his or her chosen discipline through practical application of classroom learning. The selected student is expected to give a presentation regarding their summer work at an AWRI internal seminar to be held at the end of the summer. **Applicants are requested to complete an employment application, submit a resume, and compose a one-page essay addressing the criteria listed below.**

The recipient of the internship is expected to work up to 40 hours per week on AWRI projects for 14 weeks during the summer semester 2016 and will be compensated up to \$5,572 in wages, \$500 for travel allowance, and \$500 for supplies as part of their research project. - ◆ past academic performance with emphasis on improvement
- ◆ a genuine interest in our environment and the preservation of our natural resources
- ◆ an appreciation for the American way of life and our free enterprise system
