### **Old Business**

Discussion of Revision of Rubrics – Ethical Reasoning, Oral Communication, Problem Solving
 Members discussed the AAC&U VALUE rubrics for Oral Communication and Problem
 Solving. Oral Communication looks like a good fit. Members would like the definition
 and explanations modified to reflect our GE needs. Members believe that the Problem
 Solving rubric needs to be adjusted in order to fit the GE needs. Members had questions
 about "implements the solution" since some courses cannot make that work in the
 course.

#### **New Business**

• Discussion of Honors Program Draft Proposal

Honors has proposed to leave GE and function as a separate entity. Under their proposal, they will teach the GE Skills SLOs but not the Knowledge SLOs.

Thorpe moved to support the proposal, to recommend the Quantitative Literacy option taught in Honors courses, and to add a sentence that stipulates if a student drops out of Honors the GE Director – in consultation – with the Honors Director and/or Unit Head - will determine which GE categories have been fulfilled.
