Reminders

During the winter months the CEC will always go outside two times a day; one time around 11:30 prior to lunch and again at 4:00. The CEC will not take the children outside if the temperature or wind chill is at or below 0°. Staff will always take into consideration how much time the children spend outside according to how cold it is and at times may only spend up to ten minutes outside. Even if brief the fresh air and ability to let out some energy is very beneficial to the children. The CEC staff will always make sure that each child is dressed with the clothing that is being provided from home. If their clothing is wet from an earlier time outside the CEC does have some extra winter clothing and will make sure the children are fully clothed in winter gear.

Please note that we also do our best to remember who owns what clothing and try to keep each child's possessions within their own cubby but things do fall out and get moved around. Please help the CEC staff by labeling your child's clothing and belongings with their name so that we can place it back in the appropriate cubby and make sure that the items return to the rightful owner.

Please make sure to bring a pair of shoes for your child in addition to their boots. This helps allow for the classroom floors to be dry and mud free.
