Out-of-state students who receive a GVSU tuition differential scholarship will be able to use that scholarship towards the cost of this program. Exception: international students will not have access to the tuition differential scholarship for use towards the cost of study abroad, however, they may still be eligible for the Partnership Grant.

The Padnos International Center will provide (2) \$500 Partnership Grants for the 2016-17 academic year (excludes summer). If more than two students apply for this program, decisions on awards will be made based on the strength of a student's application and financial need. Students may be eligible for more than \$500, but two applicants will receive a minimum of \$500 in grant support. Decisions on awards will be made following the deadline for applications. Conditions apply.

Housing: Students can elect single accommodations for an additional fee which is paid directly to UDLA. Shared accommodations is included in the program fee.
