VOLUNTEERS NEEDED – Covert Testing Role-players

The mission of the Department of Homeland Security ~ Transportation Security Administration is to protect the nation's transportation systems while ensuring freedom of movement for people and commerce. To safeguard the successful completion of this mission, we regularly test our people, processes and technology to identify potential vulnerabilities. This is done through our Field Evaluation Team (FET).

The FET team is responsible for conducting assessments to address evaluation of our baseline systems, equipment, procedural updates, emerging threats and as directed. Within these categories, we create scenarios in which our role players will attempt to bypass security with such threats as weapons and improvised explosive devices. This is typically done in one of three areas: Checkpoint On-Person, Checkpoint In-property and Checked Baggage. To keep officers from predicting when assessments are being conducted, each month we randomize the number of tests, days of week and times of day. Testing can be done seven days a week from 5am to 9pm. including holidays.

To maximize the realistic responses, it is vitally important the officers being evaluated do not recognize our role players. Therefore, we are looking for individuals who have an interest in assisting us with this program. Once we have a list established, we will utilize it to find available role players for that months testing.
