

## Kirkhof College of Strategic Plan and Goals 2021-2025

As part of the strategic positioning process to create the 2021-2025 Grand Valley State University (GVSU) Strategic Plan, the GVSU Board of Trustees (BOT) reviewed and affirmed Reach Higher 2025 Commitments and Values to guide the creation of new statements. A university-wide strategic planning committee was assembled, informed by university and community stakeholders. The 2021-2025 Grand Valley State University (GVSU) *Reach Higher 2025* Strategic Plan and the complementing 2021-2025 Kirkhof College of Nursing (KCON) Strategic Plan are conceptual, living documents that will be continually updated as new internal and external opportunities and challenges emerge. This responsive, proactive stance will require ongoing review, regular monitoring, and modification to remain optimally relevant and useful for resource allocation, budgeting, and the assessment of institutional progress.

The 2021-2025 KCON Strategic Plan was developed through an iterative process of faculty, staff, student, and community partner meetings starting in 2021 and commenced with a review of draft content shared with the KCON Faculty Organization Committee (FOC) and strategic partners for input and endorsement. The 2021-2025 KCON Strategic Plan is therefore comprised of aspirational and strategic priorities that seek to achieve nursing professional and institutional outcomes in alignment with GVSU.
