I am pleased to announce that Judith L. Green, Professor of Education at UC Santa Barbara, has accepted our invitation to collaborate with faculty and staff on Monday, October 10th. Dr. Green will be sharing current directions in literacy research, her experience co-editing the *Handbook on Complementary Methods for Research in Education*, and practical ideas for publishing educational research today.

### **Judith L. Green, Ph.D.**

Research areas and interests: Mixed Methods Research; Ethnography; Discourse processes in reading in educational settings; Constructing literate communities within classrooms; Language interaction and social organization.

Dr. Green's teaching and research focuses on language and literacy studies, teaching-learning as social processes, and qualitative research methods.

Judith Green has been teaching for more than three decades across levels of schooling (K-6, higher education). She received her M.A. in Educational Psychology from California State University, Northridge (1970) where she studied child development and language development. She received her Ph.D. from the University of California, Berkeley, where she explored the relationships between teaching, learning, cultural and language. With colleagues, she has published articles on ethnographic research in research handbooks for the National Council of Teachers of English, the American Educational Research Association, and the international Reading Association, and had published research based books and articles on classroom discourse, and on the social construction of literate practices. Her most recent research focuses on how classroom practices support access to students across academic disciplines.
