TELL ME ABOUT THIS PROGRAM

ZURICH, SWITZERLAND: ZHAW is located in Zurich, one of the world's largest financial centers and widely considered to be the banking and chocolate capital of Switzerland.

GVSU has been partnered with ZHAW since 2012. The agreement was first established with the School of Engineering, and in 2015 expanded to include the School of Management and Law. This site offers information for students interested in the School of Management and Law. ZHAW does offer a variety of courses in English. It is strongly recommended that Business students only consider ZHAW for the Winter (ZHAW's spring) semester. Students interested in the fall would be required to stay at ZHAW until the semester ends in mid-late January.

HOW MUCH DOES THE PROGRAM COST?

The approximate fee for this program is Total Projected Cost: \$30,680- \$41,980 (2 semesters - 8 months).

FINANCIAL AID

Students typically pay for study abroad through a combination of financial aid, personal

funds, scholarships/grants and alternative loans. **Early application for financial aid is strongly recommended.**

GRANTS

STUDY ABROAD SEMESTER GRANT: The average study abroad semester grant award is \$500 per semester. Students who complete an online study abroad application by the designated priority deadline, have a 2.5 GPA and a FAFSA on file, may be eligible for a study abroad grant ranging from \$500-\$1,750/semester. Due to limited funding, not all eligible students will receive a grant.

PARTNERSHIP GRANT : \$1,000

Eligibility criteria applies:

- 2 Grant Available per year
- Students who are awarded other PIC Funding may not be awarded a Partnership Grant.
