GVSU's Overview of Process C: Resolution Process

for Harassment & Discrimination



Formal Complaint

Any individual may file a formal complaint with the Director of the Office for Title IX & Institutional Equity alleging discriminatory or harassing behavior.

Investigation

The matter will then proceed to investigation, which will be conducted by the Office for Title IX and Institutional Equity, or jointly with another office. Occasionally, a different or less formal response to the complaint may be warranted.

Draft Report

Impacted parties receive a draft report summarizing the interviews and evidence, and have the opportunity to review and comment.

Corrective Action

Impacted parties receive a draft report summarizing the interviews and evidence, and have the opportunity to review and comment.

Investigation Report

The Investigator will complete a final report, including the Investigator's analysis and findings, which will be provided to the Complainant, the Respondent and other pertinent GVSU officials as necessary to ensure proper resolution and follow-up regarding the matter.
