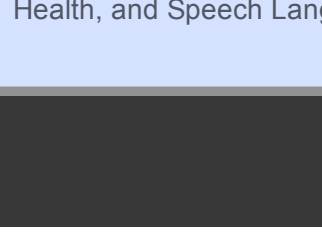


College Student Volunteer Program
