Application Process for Health Information Management

Admission Criteria

- Admission to GVSU before start of HIM program.
- Completed HIM program application.
- Minimum GPA of 2.5
- Prerequisite courses: "C" or better grade in BMS 250, BMS 251, and AHS 100
- Completion of 45 semester hours (includes current enrollment), to include prerequisite courses.
- Official and updated copies of ALL non-GVSU transcripts sent directly to the GVSU Admissions Office
