Core Services

Our Mission is to create opportunities for independence and acceptance in the communities by supporting people in making choices, building relationships, sharing places, developing skills enhancing reputations, and contributing back.

Community Supports



Mentors of Community Supports assist individuals living in the community by helping them to meet their goals through mentoring, skill building, training, advocacy, and support in general living skills. These assignments are one-on-one or in community based skill building programs. Must be at least 19 and possess a high school diploma or GED.

Clinical Supports



Supports Coordinators provide individualized clinical support and planning to individuals in specialized residential programs in Kent County. A Bachelor's Degree in social work, currently licensed or eligible for immediate licensure/ certification in the state of Michigan is required.

Specialized Residential



Residential Support provide treatment and training applying our gentle teaching approach to adults in small community based homes throughout western Michigan. These settings serve individuals who have a primary need for 24 hour support. Must be at least 18 and possess a high School diploma or GED.

Autism Services for Children Specialized Skill Building



Youth Autism Specialists work with children with autism, 18 and under, developing skills via one-on-one treatment through Applied Behavioral Analysis (ABA). A Bachelor's Degree in a Human Services field is required and/or an equivalent amount of education and experience.



Mentors of Specialized Skill Building, Summa, Continuum and Jobs assist individuals to develop greater awareness of local resources and become contributing members of their community. The community based skill building program is utilized to enhance relationships, increase community interactions, teach hands-on life skills, and provide exposure to new opportunities. We do this by supporting each individual's plan of service. Mentors of Specialized Skill Building require a Bachelor's Degree in a Human Services field, and/or equivalent amount of education and experience.
