At time of application, all prerequisite courses must have been completed within 5 years from date of degree completion.

- A candidate will be able to select one program (Traditional or Hybrid) as their first choice; candidates may also opt to include the other program as their second choice for admission consideration.
- Program accepts 40 students into traditional program and 22 for the hybrid program.
- Candidates must complete all prerequisite courses and earn a bachelor's degree prior to entering the program. There will be no waivers or exceptions to this policy.
- Completed applications must be OTCAS "**Verified**" by application deadline.
- All applications must include final summer semester grades.
- A GVSU Graduate application must also be completed to the GVSU Admissions Office.
