

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Tuition & Study Philosophy

Tuition Cost

Tuition is based on the classification of the student and the course: undergraduate lower or upper division, graduate, resident, or non-resident. Some Grand Valley colleges, schools, and departments carry an additional tuition charge per credit hour for 300 level and above courses. The charge offsets the higher costs in those particular areas.

Full-time... 12 – 15 credits (approx. \$6,900 semester)

Part-time... 11 credits or less (approx. \$580 per credit)

Study Philosophy

For every one hour spent in class at GVSU a student should study 2 to 3 hours outside of class.

15 credit hours + 30 study hours = 45 hours per week
