Phlebotomy Training

Training for the field varies. It should include classroom instruction plus "X" amount of clinical hours; however, not all programs offer the clinical hours. Students interested in this work should research their options and select a program that meets their needs.

Note: Most hospitals prefer candidates with certification but will consider applicants without (and will train).
