Narrative description of presentation/discussion and details on what was approved or unapproved in the request:

The organization is requesting funds for a spring break trip in which a group of students will be doing relief effort in Houston Texas. The organization is requesting funds for van rentals for this trip. The organization has estimated that the trip will cost around \$9000.00, but without fuel and food, this is much lower. If the vans are funded in full, each student still must pay \$300 each as a personal contribution. Last year, the group

took 5 minivans, but taking the 2 vans for the entire week would be around the \$2000.00 mark.

Funds are requested for a travel request for 2-7 passenger vans, and this would increase the overall total for rentals to \$235.04. VP Aller explained that the board only provides 50% of the funds needed for travel requests when taking into account lodging, transportation, and registration. The new number, when cutting the overall fundable costs in half would be \$117.52, and the board asked to see if there are any other costs that they could cover, but vans are the only costs that the group needs to pay for.

Narrative description of presentation/discussion and details on what was approved or unapproved in the request:

Funding is being requested for sack lunches for the professionals that will be presenting at a pre-professional fair held by the club. There will be around 80 professional representatives. Food within the request is also meant for the students. The board expressed concern that 100 sack lunches would be too much, and possibly 90 would be more appropriate. The board discussed possibly funding more for the students in attendance, which would mean increase the amount of pizzas. The board discussed how this would be similar to the senior citizen's event where the board would consider funding non GV students because the professionals are integral to the event. The board also discussed the merit of the promotions, and they seemed reasonable.

Narrative description of presentation/discussion and details on what was approved or unapproved in the request:

Funds are being requested for a panel discussion in Caesar's arena in order to do some professional networking. Specific funds are requested for van costs and registration. 40 people are coming, and the club is paying for \$460 of registration and their transportation. The board explained that unfortunately the panel tickets get groups into the actual game, and because of this, the tickets would not be eligible to be funded. The board raised the point that the board might take into account the extra van that they are not asking for, but the board decided that they would only take into account the \$170 for the 2 vans. The organization raised the point that many members last year were able to get shadowing opportunities, and that this is not just a game, but it is a conference for professional development. The board debated whether or not they should fund the tickets. The argument was that the board did not fund another group to have tickets to see the game, and it might not be fair to fund this group and not the other. However, the club made the point that because it is the Sport Management Club, the game could be seen as integral to the event. The board discussed if they should follow their precedent of not funding tickets like this, and that possibly in the future, the board could discuss changing the policy of funding tickets for this club in particular.

They explained that the Arabic teacher will be volunteering their time, and the extra supplies that the group will be purchasing will be used for other clubs and will be stored in Kirkhof. Funding is requested for a Convening Leaders conference, which lasts 4 days. The organization provided a breakdown of costs, which broke down transportation, the hotel prices, conference registration, and membership fees. The organization explained that 2 vans would be needed, and it was confirmed that this cost would be at \$590 for both, and the board would primarily look at registration. It was confirmed that the total cost that the board could pay for would be at \$6240, so \$2000.00 would be far below the half-way point, so the board was entirely comfortable with the \$2,000.00 amount.

Narrative description of presentation/discussion and details on what was approved or unapproved in the request:

Funding is being requested to bring in Moises Serrano, an advocate for immigration reform. They will also be bringing in a documentary that features the speaker, and highlights the intersectionality between immigrant and LGBTQ issues. It was noted that line item 1 should be adjusted to \$1108.96, and that line item 3 should be changed to \$113.00. This is based on most recent quotes. The organization also explained that they were working with OMA and the LGBTQ Center to organize, promote, and help give funds this event. The event is also LIB 100 approved. The board mentioned that they might consider adding a promotions package on to the request just because the speaker is so expensive and it would be beneficial to help them promote this. The organization decided on Package 2 plus the \$10 posting fee, and the board was supportive of this.
