

Equipment Details

Describe the equipment your organization wants to purchase and how the equipment will be used. - The equipment is a small refractor telescope with a motor mount for tracking and viewing. This telescope will be used for open stargazing events that take place throughout each semester during relatively warm and clear nights on campus and at the local Grand Ravine Dog Park next to campus.

Why does your organization need this equipment?

- This is an essential part of our club to have access to telescopes for the purpose of Astronomy and education through stargazing and astrophotography.

How long is the equipment expected to last?

- This equipment was vetted for quality and practicality and will be fully operational for 3-5 years and functional for up to 10 years. The refractor telescope comes with a 1-year warranty and the motor mount has an optional 1, 2, or 3-year warranty.

If the equipment is damaged or malfunctions, what is the plan to repair the equipment?

- Beyond the warranty date when repairs are guaranteed by the distributor, a reliable plan for repairing and damage or malfunctions is to reach out to the Grand Rapids Amateur Astronomy Association (GRAAA). Both Mark Hilary and I are members and have direct contact with the organization. They are our best resource for troubleshooting and repairing equipment.

Please explain how your organization has researched the vendor and pricing information.

- We set out looking for a small lightweight motorized mount that is best for tracking and viewing most objects. This led us to the reputable industry standard seller for amateur astronomy equipment: Oceanside Photo & Telescope (OPT). Searching for a small 4 inch diameter telescope allows for a lighter weight mount which decreases the cost by a large margin. This small scope is also better for viewing and photography in the amount of light pollution present in Allendale. The small scope was picked for its quality and use for astrophotography. This scope is ideal for those higher light polluted skies and for viewing most objects. It also comes with a hard case to protect it from damage while

in transit. This scope is also adaptable and can be used with many different cameras, lenses, filters and other setups and equipment that will allow this scope to perform exceptionally for many years.

Is this the most cost-effective option available?

- For the functionality and longevity of this equipment there would be few setups that could have a similar price range and durability as these two pieces of equipment together. Given the warranty, the hard case, proper storage, and quality, this telescope and mount will last far longer than a cheaper non-motorized mount and a less professional style refractor telescope.

- This equipment should be stored on campus in a dry mild temperature room. The exact location on campus is not important as long as the equipment is stored properly and never stacked or left open.

Who will have access to this equipment's storage location?

- Our faculty advisor, e-board membeOur faculty advisor, e-board members, and club members that have gone through telescope operation training for this specific piece of equipment to ensure they understand all the procedures for storing and operating the equipment. This will be training done by both Mark Hilary and I each semester for members who are willing to take the time to train to use the telescope. Telescope check out will also be necessary.
