- c. Amount Requested: \$879.50
- d. Description of Request: Latino Student Union alongside the Office of Multicultural Affairs is hosting a luncheon to honor Cesar Chavez and a chosen speaker before a presentation on immigration and the effect that Cesar Chavez has on today's society.
- e. Discussion: The organization has been doing this event in collaboration with OMA for years now. The event allows people to learn about Cesar Chavez's legacy. LSU will only be in charge of catering because OMA is covering everything else. VP Crawford states the event looks great. Catering is currently at

\$21 per head which is not in line with the funding board's rules. VP Ibarra asks how they are calculating how many students are attending and the organization responds that they are expecting more than 40 because it is in the Grand River Room. VP Crawford explains that we can only fund catering for GV students. VP Ibarra brings up that there is a Cesar Chavez committee that might be interested in helping cosponsor this event.
