

The Cultural Funding Board meeting was called to order at 1:01pm on October 10, 2016. There were 3 hearing requests; Black Student Union, African Student Council, and Native American Student Association.

The 1st request was from the Black Student Union for an event called Cafe Mahogany. The funding request was originally \$3,520.00; however, the board and I agreed to approve the request upon pending. This means the chairperson of the Black Student Union has to do the following by Friday in order to receive the funds. They must contact promotions to get a package price and contact campus dining to obtain a detailed outline of what kind of food will be served. However, the event will be on October 29th from 7pm until 11pm inside the Grand River Room.

The 2nd request was from the African Student Council for their Global Lounge event. The funding request was originally \$3,866.00; however, it was cut down and approved at \$3,601.00. (Take a look at both attachments) They raised and contributed \$200 towards the event. The event is set to take place on October 21, 2016 at 7pm until 10:30pm inside Pere Marquette.

The 3rd request was from the Native American Student Association for their 19th Annual NASA Celebrating All Walks Of Life Traditional POW Wow. The funding request was and approved at \$8,445.00 vs. last year's request which was \$8,026.00. However, the event is set to take place on April 8th & 9th at 11am. At 1:30pm the meeting ended with a total of \$15,566 request approved. The next Cultural Funding Board meeting will be held on October 24, 2016 at 1pm inside Kirkhof room 1142.
