### **Admission & Application Information**

There is no admission deadline for the Allied Health Sciences Health Professional Degree Completion (AHS/HPD) major. Enrollment will occur on a rolling basis over the academic year at the start of the next semester. The procedure for application requires the following:

- Admission to GVSU with a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.5.
  - ✓ <u>Before</u> applying to the AHS/HPD major you must be formally admitted to GVSU and have received your official evaluation of transfer credits.
- Demonstrate transcript and professional documentation fulfilling <u>ALL three criteria</u>:
  - ✓ Possess an earned Associate of Science or Associate of Applied Science from a school accredited by the Higher Learning Commission.
  - ✓ The Associate of Science or Associate of Applied Science must be in a health profession program requiring external accreditation by the professional body regulating that profession.
  - ✓ The health profession offers national voluntary credentialing or requires state licensing and the student either possesses or is eligible for earning that credential or license.

  - ✓ Once the CHPSS office receives & processes your application an advisor will be in touch to work through your personal academic plan and cover the remaining steps needed to register for classes.

#### **University Requirements**

To graduate with a GVSU bachelor's degree a student needs a minimum of 120 credits. The Allied Health Sciences Health Professional Degree Completion major allows **up to 80 credits** to apply toward the required 120 credits. If the required associate degree is less than 80 credits, the additional credits (to reach 80) can be done at any university or community college. The remaining 40 credits (of the 120) must be earned from a senior institution (university) with 30 of those credits required to be taken at GVSU.
