**Build Events**

Air Trajectory, Bungee Drop, Scrambler, Tower, Electric Vehicle, Mission Possible, Wind Power, Robot Tour, and Helicopter require a pre-built competition device. The current team members or alternates must construct all devices.

- **Coaches are required to certify** each team member/alternate has built the devices. This verification is included on the final registration form mentioned above.

**Competition Award Ceremony and Event Locations**

- Science Olympiad will hold events in the GVSU Fieldhouse Arena & Rec Center. Other areas that we normally utilize for events and team rooms will still be utilized (Cook-Dewitt Center, Kindschi Hall of Science, Kirkhof Center, Mackinac Hall, Manitou, and Padnos Hall).
- The Science Olympiad Exhibition Hall and the Awards Ceremony will be held in the GVSU Fieldhouse Arena. There will be NO EVENTS in the Turf Building this year.
- **PLEASE NOTE:** Additional waiver forms may be needed by individual students who want to participate in extra-curricular activities that may be offered on campus. These forms will be made available to coaches to communicate to their team members.

- Considerable effort has been made to match the Region 12 schedule to the State schedule; due to time and facility constraints, Regional, State, and National schedules differ.
- **Team Numbers:** This is your official tournament team number (randomly assigned) and all events will be scheduled using it. Be sure all team members know this number.

**Self-Scheduling**

Avogadro will be used by all teams to schedule events.

- **Self-scheduled events are done through Avogadro and for Primary Teams opens on Monday, March 3, 2025, at 8:00 a.m. and closes Sunday, March 23, 2025, at 12:00 a.m.** Self-scheduling selections are made on a first come, first served basis. **Alternate teams will schedule beginning on March 10 at 8:00 a.m.** *Self-scheduled Alternate teams must compete **after** the Primary team for their school.*

Team Composition
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ Division C teams can have a maximum of seven 12<sup>th</sup> grade students</li> <li>➤ Division B teams can have a maximum of five 9<sup>th</sup> grade students. <b>Trial Event</b> The trial event will NOT count toward team scores. The events are intended for alternates, but registered team members may participate. You can indicate if you are competing in the trial event when you register online. Only one team per school is eligible for a medal at a trial event.
