

# Mission Possible B Video Instructions Region 12 Grand Valley State University Michigan Science Olympiad Tournament, March 15-20

Failure to comply with these instructions may result in disqualification.

#### Before the Event

- 1. You might want to practice recording your device prior to your time slot.
- 2. Self-schedule a time to virtually compete in Scilympiad
- 3. Practice, Practice!
- 4. Ensure your device meets competition specifications
- 5. Submit Action Sequence List (ASL) to msor12@gvsu.edu by Monday, Mar 15 at 9 am.

### At the Self-Scheduled Time of the Event

- 1. At the beginning of your self-scheduled slot, log in to Scilympiad to get your password. You will need to show this password in your video(s) to be scored for the event. The password is unique to your time block to ensure that you are creating your video during the designated competition time.
- 2. Teams are allowed only a single run of the device during their self-scheduled time slot. Video recording(s) should start promptly after obtaining your password.
- 3. Teams that don't include the password in their video(s) or have a significant delay between password download and video recording will be scored in a lower tier.
- 4. Teams that show evidence of time stamp manipulation or other deliberate violation of these rules will be disqualified from the event.

## **Event Competition and Video Recording**

- Multiple videos from different angles (up to three total) can be used so that all transfers are seen clearly. Start all videos simultaneously after downloading your password.
  One video can be used for steps 2-4, but other videos should running during this time.
  Only the two competitors should be speaking, but others can record videos.
- 2. Show the password on the video (it can be written).
- 3. Place a standard meter stick next to your device, along each dimension and read each dimension aloud accurate to 0.1 cm, to ensure it is within the specifications.
- 4. Give a quick preview of the energy transfers, stating and showing where each occurs in the device, as outlined on your ASL. This will help the Event Supervisors score your device accurately.
- 5. Run your device once. Transfers that are not clearly seen on video will not be scored.
- 6. Promptly submit your video(s) via Scilympiad. You can share a link of private YouTube video, Google Drive folder, etc. as videos can be large to upload.
