### Region 12 Administrative Information

#### Team Number

Your team number is listed on the regional website: [www.gvsu.edu/mso-r12/team](http://www.gvsu.edu/mso-r12/team). This is your official regional number (randomly assigned) and all events will be scheduled using it. Be sure all team members know this number.

Considerable effort has been made to match the Regional schedule to the State Schedule; however, due to time and facility constraints Regional, State, and National schedules differ.

#### Region 12 Registration

#### Scheduling in Coaches Portal

#### Required Volunteers

Each school is requested to provide three volunteers by February 21, 2018.

#### Team Rooms/Gathering Spaces

- All teams will be assigned limited space on the bleachers in the Fieldhouse for the opening/closing ceremonies.
- Each team will be assigned shared space in one of GVSU's classrooms. Teams may only use assigned rooms as formal gathering spaces.
- Requests to share space with other schools and the number of your team members can be done during registration online. Requests are based on this information.
- Meals/snacks are allowed in classrooms, not in hallways. If you need more trash bins for your classroom, contact a volunteer or RMSC staff. Classrooms are to be cleaned before you leave and any items left behind will be brought to the Fieldhouse the day of the event. Thereafter, any unclaimed items will be discarded.

### Devices

The current team members or alternates must construct all devices. Coaches are required to sign a statement confirming that each team member/alternate has built the device. This affidavit will be included on the Final Registration form that is turned in the day of the event, March 17, 2018, at check-in.

### Team Composition

Division C teams can have a maximum of seven 12<sup>th</sup> grade students and Division B teams can have a maximum of five 9<sup>th</sup> grade students. ### Trial Events
