- 301 & 302 are prerequisites for all 300-level courses except 321; one may be taken concurrently with other 300-level courses after the other has been completed.
- Majors must take one 400-level course (401/402/421) in the semester before the Capstone.
- Students must achieve advanced low on the OPI Interview before beginning student assisting in the College of Education.
- **Students are required to study abroad for at least one semester (12-15 credits at the 300-level) in a German-language program.** For students who are unable to complete this requirement due to familial, financial, or other concerns, alternatives do exist.
