Tuition Costs

- Additional charges for on-campus housing and meal plans will vary based on student's choice

 - —Two additional email addresses
- Must have the student's G # and PIN to see the eBill

Payments for the Fall 2016 semester are due by 5pm on August 19th

Payment Options:

- Pay any remaining balance owed by August 19th
- Enroll in the deferment plan four equal payments each semester
 - There is a \$40 fee each semester that you are on the deferment plan
 - First payment is due August 19th

Non-payment will result in classes being dropped!
