#### Cost

Program Fee: \$894.00\* (Paid to GVSU)
Includes field trips, lodging and 13 meals/week.

Tuition\*\*: \$3,126 - \$4,602 (Paid to GVSU)

**Other Expenses: \$125** - recommended to cover personal expenses.

\*6 days of working at Camp Henry are required to offset some of the program costs. Students who fail to complete the 6 days of service will be required to pay an additional fee of \$480.

\*\*Tuition will be based on number of credits already earned, and Michigan Resident or Non-Michigan Resident status.

Total Estimated Cost: \$4,145 - \$5,621
